

Maths

Children will study these areas over this term:

- Number (Including all operations, place value)
- Fractions
- Shape and positioning

English

Children will be investigating the topic Myths, Legends and Fantastic beasts and will cover these texts and text types:

- Narrative –Robin hood and other local myths and legends
- Non-fiction - newspaper / adventure story / decision book/ wanted poster/ diary entry
- Children will receive 2 hours of Guided Reading lessons a week, & 1 hour of SPaG lessons a week.

Science

Children will be studying Plants, including how they are structured and how to ensure optimal growth.

During this term children will study Light and Sound, including light sources, how light is created, shadows, how the ear works and vibrations.
