Road safety: Please ensure that you park safely and considerately when bringing and collecting your children from school. It is important for the safety of our pupils and also of Nacton residents that vehicles are not parked on the white lines.

Footwear for the field: It is getting to the time of year when our field starts getting a bit muddy! If children wish to use the field they will need to have a pair of wellies, trainers or other suitable footwear to change into. If they do not have a change of footwear in school then they will need to stay on the playground.

Earrings: Please remember if pupils wear earrings in school then they need to be able to remove them for PE or cover them with tape. If your child is swimming, Suffolk Norse's policy is that children should have all earrings removed, this is for their own safety. As a school we agree with this policy.
