

COVID-19 Addendum

Pupils are still expected to follow the usual school rules. Staff will continue to sanction and praise pupils' behaviour choices.

Due to the risks that staff, pupils and families could face due to the COVID-19 virus there are a number of new expectations on pupils that they need to follow to ensure the safety of the whole school community:

- Following the altered routines for arrival and departure
- Following school instructions on hygiene, such as washing hands properly and frequently
- Following instructions on who pupils can socialise with at school
- Following the one way system in the corridor
- Following the one person in the toilet rule
- Not using the wooden play equipment on the field.
- Ensuring they follow the 'catch it, bin it, kill it' process when coughing or sneezing.
- Avoid touching their mouths, nose and eyes with their hands
- Immediately tell an adult if they are feeling unwell
- To use only their own resources e.g. pens, pencils. Only sharing resources when directed by an adult
- Not to handle anyone else's resources, including their water bottles and food
- Older pupils to try to maintain some form of social distancing when at play time.
- Older pupils to stay at their desks, when in the classroom, unless directed to move by an adult. They must not touch any other pupils' desk or belongings
- Coughing or spitting in anyone's direction is completely unacceptable
- The need to 'line up' will be reduced significantly. When pupils need to line up at the end of play time they will stand on their own marker, markers will be spaced out as close to 2m as possible.

Parents must share these with their child. Staff will also ensure pupils know the new rules and expectations.
