Parent's Evening: We're looking forward to welcoming you to parent's evenings this week. Please remember the procedures below, which we're putting in place to ensure it is COVID-19 safe:

- children will **not** be able to attend with parents/carers
- a one way system will be in place, with parents entering the school via the playground and exiting via the school office (signs will show the route)
- parents/carers will wait on the playground, before their appointment
- chairs will be available and cleaned in between use
- slots will be for 10 minutes, no longer, with a bell ringing to mark the end of the meeting (if the 10 minutes cuts the conversation short, additional time can be arranged for a separate meeting, if necessary)
- windows and doors will be open for ventilation
- staff and parents/carers will be sat 2m apart
- parents/carers to wear masks while on the school grounds

Reading Picnics: As outlined in a letter last week, we're inviting parents to join us for a reading picnic as parents won't be able to join us for Sports Day. If you haven't signed up to join us for one of these, please do, it will be great to have parents in school again.

This will enable the children to meet their new teachers ahead of the summer holidays without impacting on the number of children in the bubbles.
